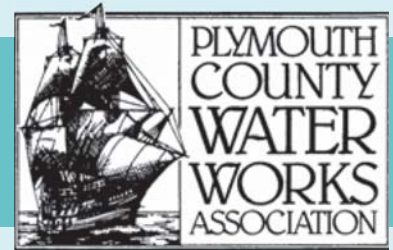


Please join us for our next course
