Skilled Water Distribution Mechanic

The Town of Hanover, Department of Public Works has a position available for a skilled water distribution mechanic. This P-5 position requires a high school diploma or equivalent, a minimum Grade IID or IIC Drinking Water Supply Operators Certification, a Cross Connection Inspector and Surveyor's Certificate, a Class B CDL with air brake endorsement, and a Class 1B Hoisting Engineer's license. The pay scale is \$20.13 to \$21.81 per hour plus applicable license stipends.

The successful candidate will be responsible for the operation and maintenance of water distribution facilities under the direction of the Water Distribution Foreman. He or she shall have a minimum of three years experience in a public works environment or equivalent experience, and shall have a basic general knowledge of public works operations and operation of water distribution facilities. The position requires physical work inside and outside in all weather conditions. Participation in the Town's snow and ice program and after hours planned and emergency operations and maintenance of water distribution facilities are essential and mandatory requirements of this position. The successful applicant will be expected to participate in the Department's on-call program, providing night and weekend emergency service on a rotating basis with other water division employees.

If selected for employment, the candidate shall undergo a pre-employment physical which shall include screening for drugs and alcohol and shall be subject to random drug and alcohol testing once hired.

This is a 40 hour per week position working Monday thru Friday. The complete job description and application are available at the DPW office, 40 Pond Street, Hanover MA 02339.
